WHEREAS, the Board of Police Commissioners of Kansas City, Missouri (Board) is vitally interested in the cost effective construction of new police facilities provided for by passage of the Quarter-Cent Public Safety Sales Tax in 2002, and

WHEREAS, the Capital Improvements Unit of the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department has expended considerable time and effort in examining and studying the suitability of thirty-eight (38) potential sites for construction of the new Metro Patrol Division Station, and

WHEREAS, based on a number of financial and operation criteria, the Capital Improvements Unit concluded that the site located at 6401 Rockhill Road is the most suitable and cost-effective location for construction of the new Metro Patrol Division Station, and

WHEREAS, the Board, concurring in this conclusion, recognizes that further delays in the site selection process will postpone the construction of the new Metro Patrol Division Station and that postponement of construction will result in a significant increase in the cost of the new station, and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board does hereby support the selection of the 6401 Rockhill Road site, and respectfully encourages and requests that the City Council of Kansas City, Missouri immediately authorize the purchase of this site for the construction of the new Metro Patrol Division Station.
