ADMINISTRATION BUREAU MEMORANDUM NO. 03-6

SUBJECT: P.O.S.T. Requirements for Racial Profiling Training

In October of 2002, the Missouri Department of Public Safety mandated that the Peace Officers Standards and Training program (P.O.S.T.) require each Officer commissioned in the state of Missouri to have one hour of Racial Profiling training per calendar year. That is not a cumulative 3 hours during the three year cycle, an officer must have one hour of this training per calendar year.

The training academy has been providing this training through our catalog program throughout the year. Currently there are 800 department members who have not received the required one hour of training for the calendar year of 2003. The training academy will provide additional courses to assist in getting all department members the required Racial Profiling training. The following is a list of dates and times the training will be offered.
