WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 84.420 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, the Board of Police Commissioners of Kansas City, Missouri (Board) has as a part of its duties the preservation of public peace, the prevention of crime and the protection of the rights of persons and property, and

WHEREAS, the Community Backed Anti-Drug Tax (COMBAT) has provided support for programs within Jackson County, Missouri, including Kansas City, that work to educate the community as to the dangers of illegal drugs, provide treatment for non-violent offenders, and assist law enforcement in the fight against drugs and the prosecution of drug and drug related offenses, and

WHEREAS, through its support of these programs, COMBAT has assisted the Board in carrying out its statutory duties, and

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2009, Jackson County voters will be asked to extend the COMBAT initiative for an additional seven (7) years,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board does hereby strongly support extension of the COMBAT initiative.
