Fatalities — Through April

Fatal #14 — I-435 and I-70 — 04/01/2021 — The driver/victim was operating a Nissan Sentra northbound on I-435 at a high rate of speed when he lost control and ran off the roadway. The Nissan went down an embankment and flipped over multiple times. The driver/victim was not wearing a seat belt and was pronounced dead at the scene.

Fatal #15 — N.W. Roanridge Rd. and N. Bethel Ave. — 04/04/2021 — The driver/victim was operating a Chevrolet Impala northbound on N.W. Roadridge Road when it ran off the roadway, went down embankment, and overturned. The driver/victim was trapped in the vehicle as it caught fire and he was pronounced dead at the scene. Seat belt use was unable to be determined.

Fatal #16 — 87th St. and 350 Hwy. — 04/05/2021 — The driver/victim was operating a Harley-Davidson motorcycle northbound on 350 Highway at a very high rate of speed. When changing lanes, the Harley-Davidson struck the rear of a Chevrolet Volt. The driver/victim was pronounced dead after being transported to a local hospital.

Fatal #17 — Penn Valley Dr. and 29th St. — 04/15/2021 — The driver/victim was operating a Saturn Aura northbound on Broadway at a high rate of speed when he lost control and struck a red Fiat. The driver/victim was wearing a seat belt, but was pronounced dead after being transported to a local hospital.


Fatal #18 — West Pennway Rd. and Belleview Ave. — 04/17/2021 — The passenger/victim was riding in a Toyota 86 that was being driven at a high rate of speed north-bound on West Pennway when the vehicle struck a tree. The passenger/victim was not wearing a seat belt and was pronounced dead after being transported to a local hospital.

Fatal #19— I-435 and N.E. 48th St — 04/01/2021 — The driver/victim was operating a Toyota Corolla at a high rate of speed southbound on I-435 when it rear-ended a stopped Freightliner semi-truck's trailer. The driver/victim was not wearing a seat belt and was pronounced dead at the scene.



Fatal #20 — Independence Ave. and Brighton Ave. — 04/25/2021 — The driver/victim was operating a Ford Taurus eastbound on Independence Avenue when he crossed the centerline and struck a Chevrolet Van head-on. The driver/victim was not wearing a seat belt and was pronounced dead after being transported to a local hospital.




#### Fatal Crash Statistics — 2021




The graph reflects percentages from 20 fatal crashes with 20 people killed in 2021.


#### Fatal Crash Statistics — 2020
